The below parameters are supported by the <textarea> tag.

TEXTAREA TAG PARAMETERS		
Attribute	Value	Description
id	Required: False Runtime expression value: True	This is a unique ID for the textarea object which can be used to refer to the element
Name	Required: False Runtime expression value: True	This is the name given to a designated textarea
cssClass	Required: False Runtime expression value: True	This overrides the default CSS class
params	Required: False Runtime expression value: True	This allows to pass a set of parameters to the HTML
cols	Required: False Runtime expression value: True	This indicates the visible number of columns in the textarea
rows	Required: False Runtime expression value: True	This indicates the visible number of rows in the textarea

TEXTAREA TAG PARAMETERS

Attribute	Value	Description
tabIndex	Required: False Runtime expression value: True	This gives focus to the active HTML element by setting the tab order of the element. Low values are navigated first
maxLength	Required: False Runtime expression value: True	This sets the maximum number of characters for the textarea
onBlur	Required: False Runtime expression value: True	This indicates that the active textarea has lost focus because the user is pointing the cursor elsewhere.
readonly	Required: False Runtime expression value: True	This prevents the user from modifying the content in the textarea
disabled	Required: False Runtime expression value: True	This indicates that the textarea is not functional when it is displayed. Usually, this is shown by greying the content of the textarea.
